Each Participant:

1. Must provide all ingredients, grills and cooking utensils necessary to prepare and cook their entries in the presence of the Judges.
2. All food should be ready for competition judging by 4:00 p.m.
3. Each participant will be allowed a maximum of two assistants.
4. Time allotted for cooking will be four hours. (12 Noon – 4 p.m.)
5. Participants are to prepare at least 2 lbs. of meat for judging.
6. Participant must use season or spice of their choice in food preparation.
7. Food prepared for the competition judges to sample must be prepared on site.
8. Trophies and prize packages will be awarded to first, second and third place winners.
